DID YOU KNOW:

- 1,088 adults and children received services for Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault
- 4,982 hours of counseling services were provided to adults and children
 - 133 adults and children were provided safety from violence through 4,777 nights of shelter
 - 1,655 crisis hotline calls from 925 individuals seeking help
 - 843 youth were provided with prevention education through 22 programs
 - 2,517 adults participated in 38 community awareness programs
 - 794 community professionals received education through 9 training programs
